NOTE: The total number of nations, events and athletes in the respective Olympic Games vary greatly in historical publications, but the totals shown above reflect those now used by the U.S. Olympic Committee based on its official reports and other detailed, supporting documentation. Also, while some historians count the International Athletic Games or "Extraordinary Olympic Games" -- held in Athens in 1906 to mark the 10th anniversary of the revival of the Modern Olympic Games in 1896 -- as official, neither the International Olympic Committee nor the USOC recognizes the games, nor counts any medals won by athletes in these games toward official Olympic Games medal totals.
